Somalia is a complex emergency where its people have experienced conflict, floods, drought, food shortages and at times famine. Through the clusters, humanitarian actors provide support for basic services in the areas of food security, protection, nutrition, shelter, health, water and sanitation and education. Below is a graphic overview of humanitarian intervention coverage and the gaps identified across the clusters for the month of June. As data is often difficult to gather this information represents best estimates and may be under-represented if partners' activities are not reported or captured.

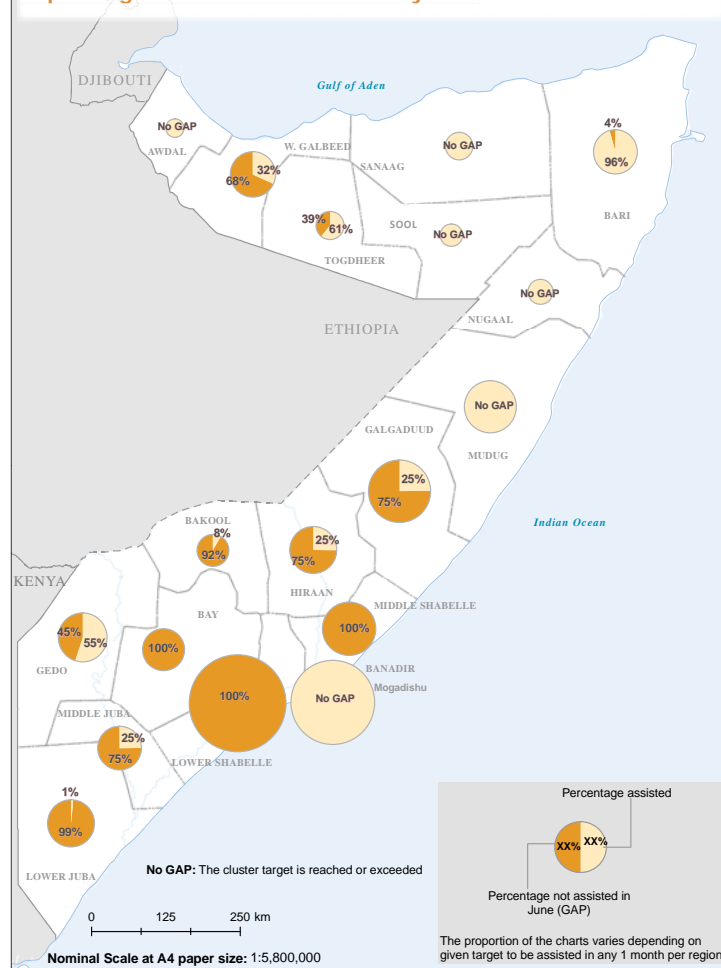
The cluster targets are a percentage of the affected population and not entire population in crisis. The size of the charts on the maps varies depending on the cluster target per region.

Food Security: 1.3 million assisted

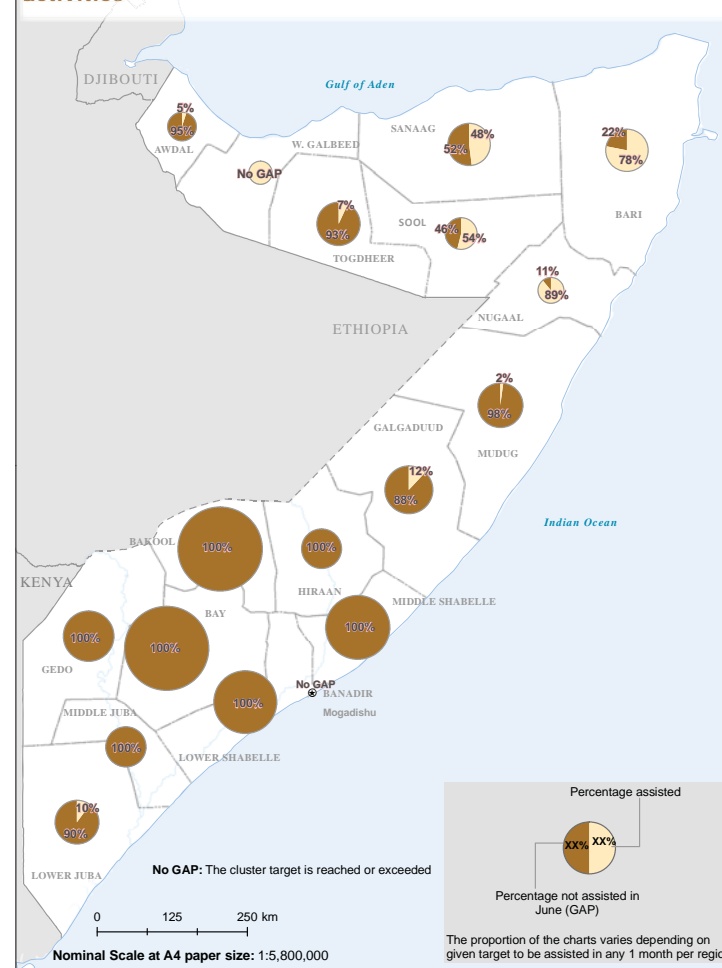
The Food Security Cluster (FSC) reached an estimated 1.3 million people throughout Somalia with responses aimed at (i) improving household access to food, (ii) investing in livelihood assets and (iii) safety nets interventions.

Support was provided through cash, vouchers, food and non-food inputs depending on the households and communities needs and IPC status, general food distributions and wet feeding.

People targeted and reached through interventions aimed at improving access to food and safety nets



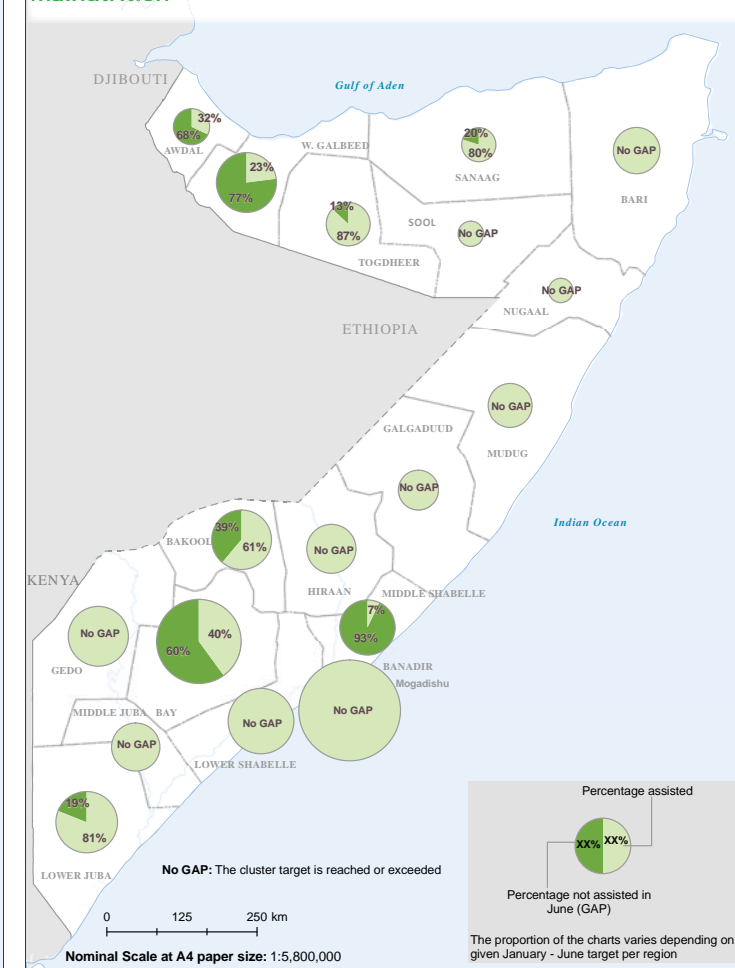
People targeted and reached through livelihood investment activities



Nutrition: 413,919 children assisted

The Nutrition Cluster partners reached a total of 413,919 malnourished children under the age of five of which 122,909 were severely malnourished (SAM) and 291,010 were moderately malnourished (MAM). The cluster also reached 806,353 children, pregnant and lactating mothers with a preventive food ration majority of whom are in south central Somalia

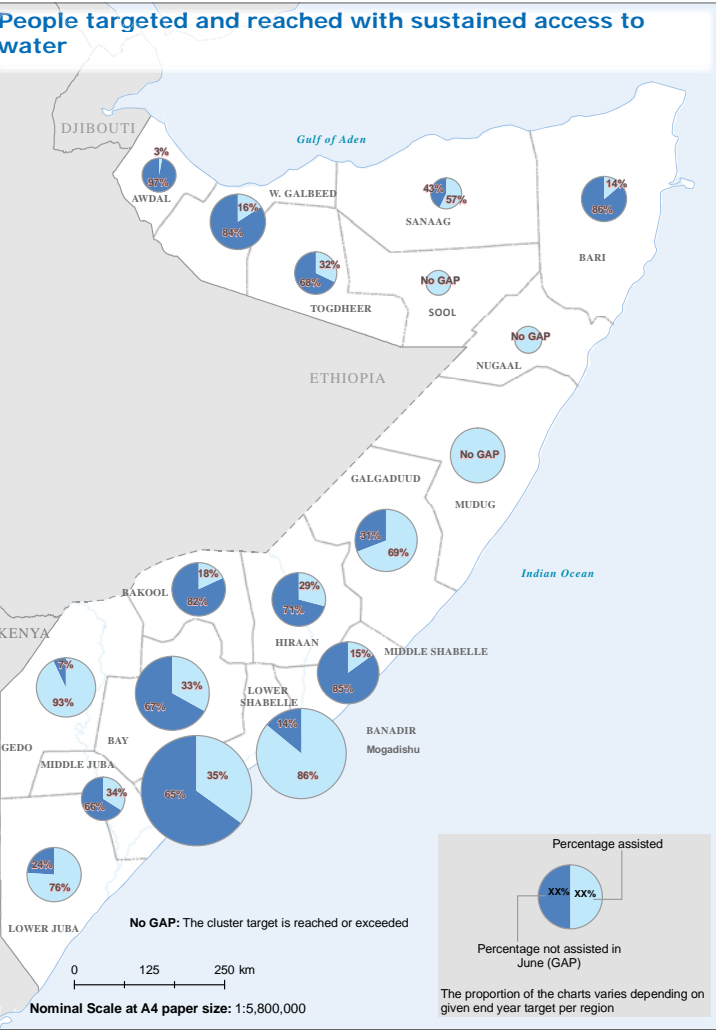
Children under five years targeted and treated for acute malnutrition

Water-Sustained: 1.3 million assisted

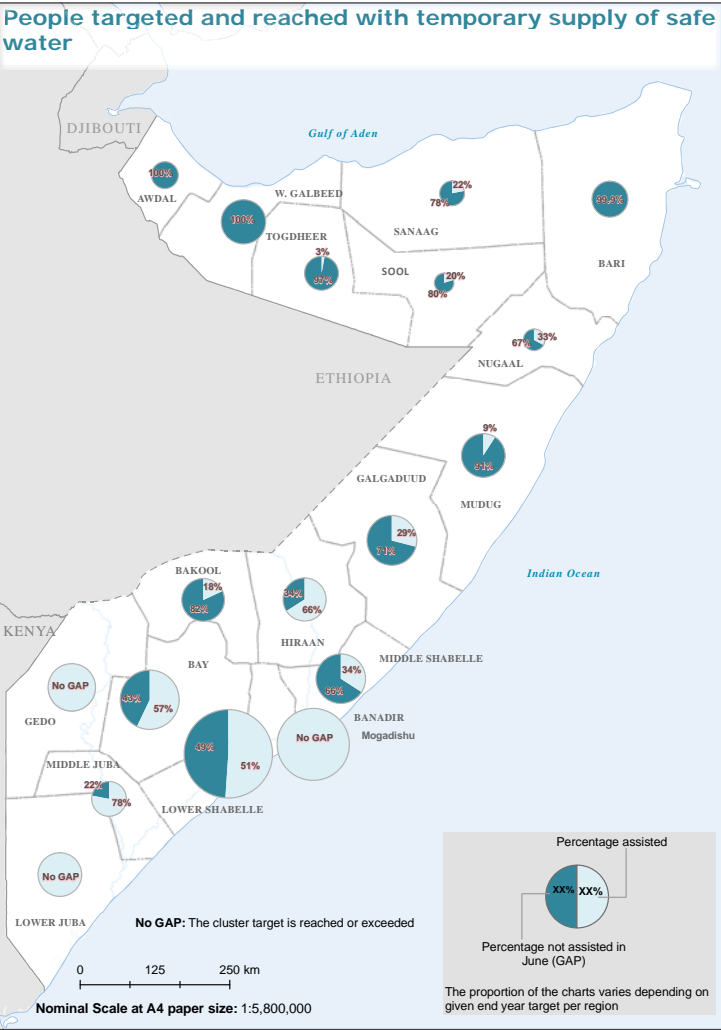
The WASH Cluster supported 51% of the 2.5 million targeted with sustainable water access in Somalia. Further, 620,162 beneficiaries were reached with sanitation facilities (latrines) of whom 337,997 are from Mogadishu, and 1.48 million people benefited from hygiene promotion and non-food item (NFI).

Water-Temporary: 1.7 million assisted

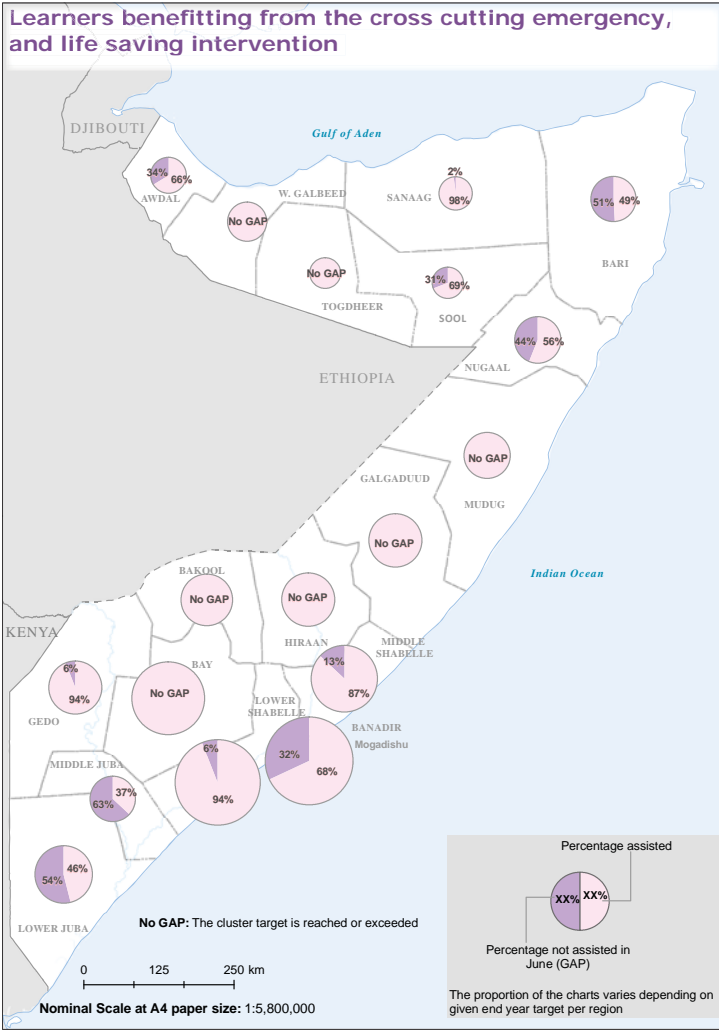
The WASH Cluster also reached 66% of the 2.5 million targeted with temporary provision of safe water, of whom majority are in the south, With continued threats of eviction of IDPs from Maajo and Aladala settlements in Mogadishu, the WASH cluster has requested for a timeline of the eviction to guide the type of WASH facilities to be installed in proposed settlements.

Education: 571,067 learners assisted

Education Cluster has reached 571,067, (252,228 girls) learners and 11,386 teachers in over 2,000 formal and non-formal learning facilities in drought and conflict affected areas. This was achieved through provision of learning supplies, provision of cross-cutting/life-saving interventions, teacher incentives and capacity building of teachers. The schools have closed for long holiday until September 2012.



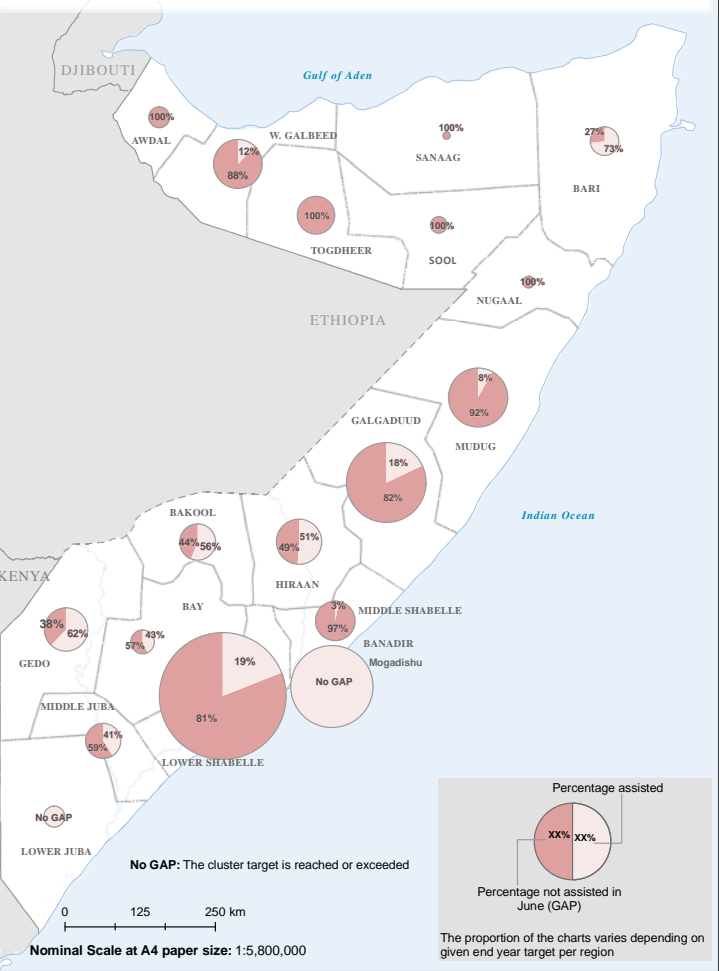

Shelter- EAPs: 533,214 assisted

The Shelter Cluster reached 46% of the 1.17 million targeted with Emergency Assistance Packages (EAPs), with over 80% of the EAPs distributed in Mogadishu. The EAP's were distributed as follows: South 475,008, Central & Puntland 51,066 and Somaliland 7,140.

People targeted and reached with Emergency Assistance Packages (EAP's)



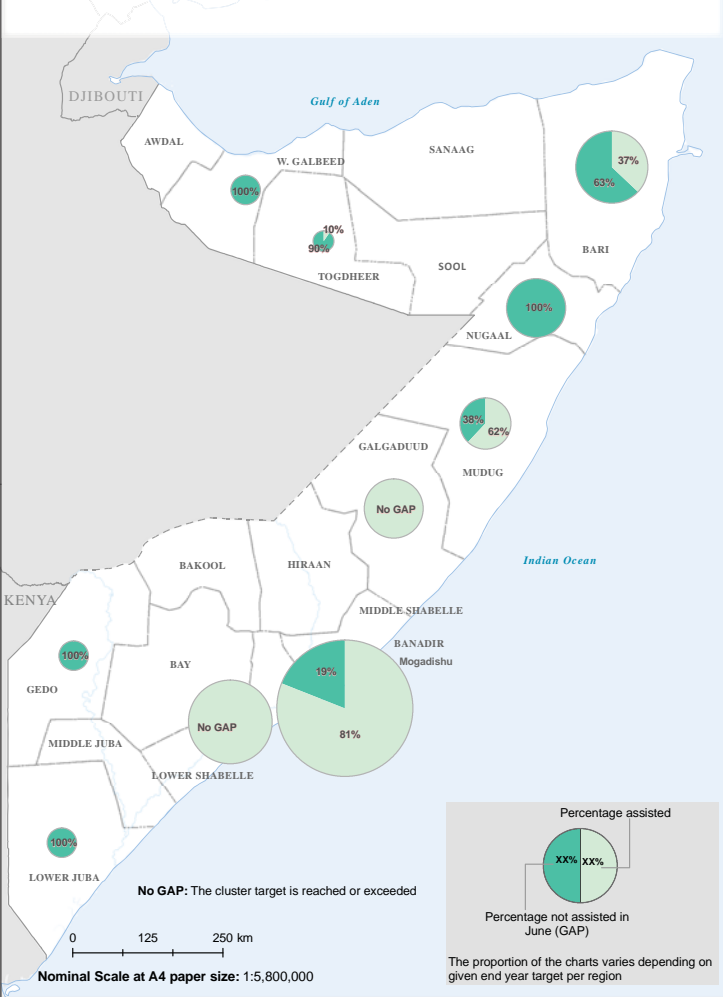

People targeted and reached with appropriate shelter



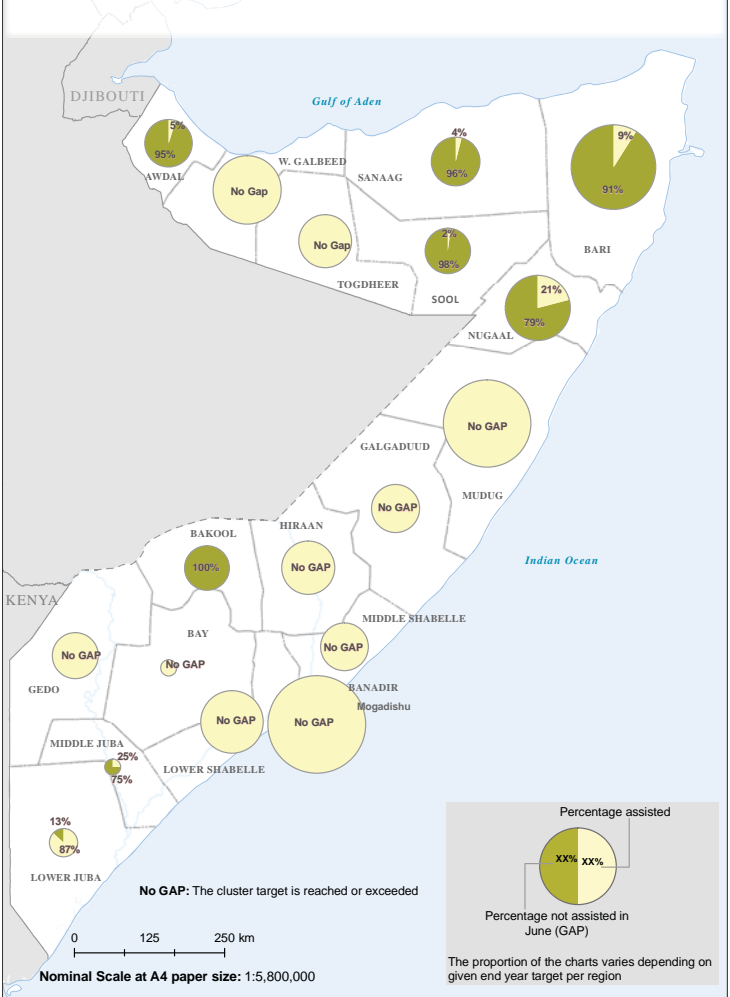

Protection: 741,639 assisted

The Protection Cluster assisted 741,639 people with responses aimed at i) Gender Based Violence (GBV) which remains one of the most preoccupying protection risks faced mostly by IDP girls, adolescents and women. ii) Response services which include medical, legal and psychosocial support, iii) Protection through livelihoods interventions and iv) capacity building on various protection themes.
